

Percutaneaous Burrs

The mini-invasive treatment of Hallux Valgus and associated hammer toes corresponds to a complementary surgical solution to classic open surgery

- In 12 Bones provides a family of 8 burrs for the Mini-Invasive surgery.
- 3 designs of Burrs are availbles.
- All burrs are delivered sterile.

INDICATIONS

Mini-invasive surgery of the forefoot can only be proposed in cases of first intention, non arthritic deformities with a congruent 1st ray (pathological DMAA angle >7°) and a metatarsus varus of less than or equal to 16°







The so-called "mini-invasive" surgical approach to Hallux Valgus has the same objectives as open surgery:

- reducing the medial volume of the 1st metatarsal head,
- reorienting the distal articular surface of the first metatarsal and correcting the DMAA by reducing the angle,
- lateral arthrolysis of the metatarsophalangeal joint of the 1st rayand lengthening its adductor,
- r- eorienting the diaphysis of P1 by varus osteotomy, so as to reposition the first phalange on the M1 head.
